Level 1: These jobs are entry-level positions. They generally do not require significant or special experience, training, or prior education. This may be an individual's first job. Nature of position: Lower-level responsibilities with little to no decision-making. (Ex: Filing, answering phones, making copies, conference room set-up (moving tables), pulling weeds, painting, etc.) Level 2: These jobs are positions that students/IH have special skills based on prior training, education, and knowledge and can be placed in directly or can develop these skills quickly with on-the-job training. Nature of position: Requires a moderate level of responsibility. May act independently in some instances. (Ex: accounting assistant, security patrol, academic tutoring, maintenance and mechanical duties, office assistant with MS Office skills, etc.) Level 3: These jobs should represent a small portion of your student/IH workforce. Reserved for those exhibiting professional level skills and responsibility. Nature of position: Requires an established skillset where the individual acts independently and has a high level of responsibility. (Ex: Instructor, trainer, researcher, coordinator, etc.)
