JENNIFER GREENY



HEAD COACH

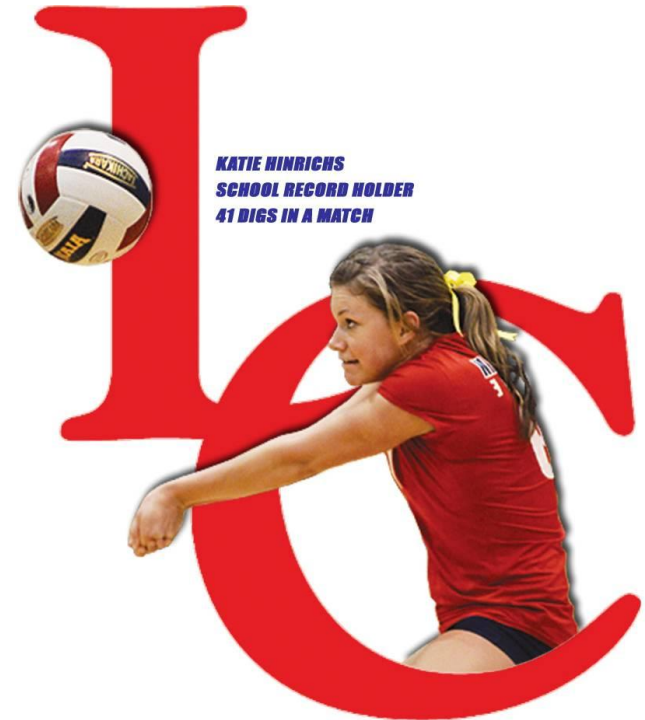
In her third year leading Lewis-Clark State, Head Coach Jennifer Greeny has made LC State into one of the premier programs not only in the Northwest, but in the western half of the United States. Turning around a program that had only 21 wins the previous three seasons to her hire, Coach Greeny's teams have proceeded to compile an 81-21 record while winning back-to-back-to-back conference regular season and tournament titles, and finished in the top 13 in the nation for three straight years. Once again numerous players garnered All-America, All-Region, and All-Conference honors, while Greeny was named conference and region coach of the year for a remarkable third time in her first three years at the helm. Prior to LC State, Jennifer's three seasons as Pullman High School head volleyball coach were the most successful in the history of the school. Her 2004-06 teams went a combined 84-12, winning the school's first volleyball state title, setting records for most wins and highest winning percentage in a season, and leading the program to it's highest three finishes ever with the state title, plus a 3rd and a 7th place finish. These efforts helped earn her three league coach of the year awards, plus the 2005 WIAA Washington State Coach of the Year. From 2000-04, Jennifer was an assistant volleyball coach at Washington State University. During her four years of coaching at WSU, the Cougars made it to the NCAA tournament three times, one of which culminating in an Elite Eight appearance. Jennifer graduated from Davenport High School in 1995, where she won one state volleyball title, two state basketball titles, and three state high jump titles. Jennifer still stands as the Washington state all-time record holder for career points (2,881) for all classifications girls and boys. She entered WSU as one of Volleyball Magazine's Fab Fifty Freshman recruits. She proceeded to earn three All-Pac 10 selections on the court and in the classroom, was named an academic All-American two times, trained with the US National Team, and became only the seventh player in WSU volleyball history with over 1,000 career kills. On WSU's career list, Jennifer ranks 3rd in block assists, 4th in total blocks, 10th in kills, and 7th in solo blocks. WSU made the NCAA tournament three times during her playing career, reaching the Elite Eight once and being ranked as high as 5th in the country. Of the 11 seasons WSU has qualified for the postseason, Jennifer was involved in 6 of the 11 seasons – three as a player and three as a coach.
