

NAIA ELIGIBILITY AND LEWIS-STATE COLLEGE'S STUDENT ATHLETE REQUIREMENTS & INTERPRETATION

No.	Rule	Columns	LCSC Interpretation	Notes for Calculation
1	Converting Quarter/Semester Credits	5, 6, 7, 8, 10	In the student-athlete's first term of full time enrollment, count quarter credits at face value. Subsequent terms of eligibility convert quarter credits to semester for the NAIA 12-24 Rule.	
2	Combine transfer and LCSC GPA	4B	In the student-athlete's first term of full time enrollment, combine ALL transfer graded points with LCSC grade points and divide by ALL GPA credits from LCSC and transfer institutions. Subsequent terms of eligibility ONLY use LCSC cumulative GPA.	Use quarter credits and grade points at face value for this GPA calculation.
3	Terms of attendance	3	Terms of attendance include and Fall, Winter, Spring full terms (not J term or Winter Semester or Summer) in which the athlete ENROLLED in 12 or more credits.	3 quarter terms = 2 semester terms for this calculation. If student ENROLLS in 9 or more credits at LCSC and an additional 3 <i>transferable</i> (or more to=12 or more for a term) credits at another institution this = a term of attendance.
4	Non-term of attendance	8	Non-terms are summer terms, J terms, Winter Semester and any term in which the student enrolled in less than a TOTAL of 12 credits for a term.	Can only count a maximum of 12 credits in a non-term toward the 12-24 rule.
5	Review of Major	10	Athletes must be baccalaureate degree seeking—check this their first term of eligibility.	
6	Remedial Courses below 100 level	3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11	Remedial courses at LCSC OR a transfer institution WILL count toward the 12-24 Rule and WILL count toward terms of attendance. Remedial courses WILL count toward 48 Rule for credits toward major.	Remedial credits from LCSC only WILL count toward the 48 rule. Transfer remedial credits will NOT count (because we don't transfer them to LCSC).
7	Concurrent Enrollment Students	11	Freshmen athletes who complete college credits while in HS WILL be listed on the Freshmen eligibility form. College credits earned while concurrently enrolled as a HS student will count in column 11 only.	
8	50% Core complete (have a passing grade in 19 cr. of Core)	4A	Athletes must complete 50% of the Core by the start of their junior year of eligibility as determined by season of competition. *Note: students not meeting this will be declared eligible if enrolled and successfully completing 2 Core or 2 remedial courses or a combination of Core and remedial courses (2) each subsequent semester until met. Summer credits may be used consistent w/ NAIA eligibility.	Successful completion of remedial courses is C, P, S or better. Successful completion of Core is D or better.

9	75% Core complete (having passed grade in 28 cr. of Core)		Athletes must complete 75% of the Core by the start of their senior year of eligibility as determined by season of competition. *Note: students not meeting this will be declared eligible if enrolled and successfully completing 2 Core or 2 remedial. courses or a combination of Core and remedial. courses (2) each subsequent semester until met. Summer credit may be used consistent w/ NAIA eligibility.	Successful completion of remedial courses is C, P, S or better. Successful completion of Core is D or better.
10	Core Eligibility Status Initial		Core Program Evaluations will be printed and evaluated by the Associate Registrar and then forwarded to the coaches for them to review with the student athletes (if they so choose).	
11	Core Eligibility Status AFTER Grades		Once grades are posted Program Evaluation will again be printed and evaluated by the AD.	
12	Idaho Independent Study Courses that LCSC Owns		ISI courses that LCSC owns will be transcribed the term in which the student first enrolls in the course, regardless of when they complete the course.	
13	Transfer Credits		Transfer credits, whether ISI or not, will be counted in the term in which they are transcribed at the transfer institution.	
14	Transcription of LCSC Directed Study Courses		LCSC will transcript courses in the term in which the student enrolled in the course.	
15	Transcript of LCSC Irregular start date courses		Classes that begin on a date not within a standard term will be transcribed in the term that immediately follows the scheduled start date of the class.	
16	Coaches First Review of Athletes		When coaches have questions regarding eligibility, they will first go to the AD. If there are still questions, AD will come to Associate Registrar and/or Faculty Rep.	
17	Coaches Inform Students		Coaches will inform athletes of ineligibility after it has been confirmed by the Associate Registrar. Potential athletes will not be sent to the Registrar's office for clarification.	
18	Entering Freshmen	*A	Achieve a minimum score of 18 of ACT or 860 on SAT. (860 SAT score must be achieved on the Critical Reading and Math sections.)	*2 out of 3 of A, B & C
19	Entering Freshmen	*B	Achieve a minimum overall HS GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.	*2 out of 3 of A, B & C
20	Entering Freshmen	*C	Graduate in upper half of HS graduating class. (Class ranking listed on student's final HS transcript. High schools that do not rank students may elect to certify the student has met this requirement.)	*2 out of 3 of A, B & C
21	GED or Home Schooled Students	D	Must meet ACT or SAT requirement.	
22	International Students	E	Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA and status of "fully admissible" in addition to a score of 18 or higher on Enhanced ACT or 860 or higher on SAT.	LCSC admission criteria for foreign students per Registrar/Admissions.
23	Petition Process		Student athletes who do not meet the requirements of number 8 or 9 will be allowed to petition to the Athletic Advisory Board via an Athletic Petition form available from the Athletic Director's Office in ACC 223	Petitioning student must be able to prove a COMPELLING reason why they could not meet the requirements of no. 8 or 9 for the petition to be granted. Appeals go to Provost.
