LCSC provides all nursing and upper core coursework and awards the BSN degree. Application to the LCSC BSN Program is competitive and requires admission to the college as well as to the Program.

General Education CORE: The University of Idaho student who meets lower general education core requirements and whose transcript is stamped accordingly will be considered as **lower core complete** at LCSC. No further general education **lower core** is required, although LCSC has upper division core requirements. These are met if students transfer in with a bachelor's degree or higher.
