**General Information:** Lewis-Clark State College offers a 4 year nursing program that culminates in a Bachelor of Science in nursing (BSN) degree. Washington State University (WSU) students are considered pre-nursing students and may take core and pre-requisite courses for the BSN degree at the WSU. LCSC provides all nursing and upper core coursework and awards the BSN degree. Application to the LCSC BSN Program is competitive and requires admission to the college as well as to the Program.

**General Education CORE:** The WSU student who meets lower general education core requirements and whose transcript is stamped accordingly will be considered as **lower core complete** at LCSC. No further general education **lower core** is required, although LCSC has upper division core requirements. These are met if students transfer in with a bachelor's degree or higher. **Social science core classes are met by the following classes: Anth 101 or 230; Econ 101 or 102; GenEd 110 or 111; Phil 260; Psc 105; Soc 101 or 102; POLS 101 or 102. Any three classes.**
