The Special Education Program prepares individuals to receive a State of Idaho Exceptional Child Certificate with a generalist endorsement. This certificate enables a special education teacher to work with students with special and individual needs in grades kindergarten through 12 (K-12). It allows teachers to work in a resource program or through inclusion in a regular classroom. Students must integrate the special education courses and internship into their elementary or secondary teacher education program to complete certification. Courses should be taken in order listed. For more information, contact a Special Ed faculty member in the Education Division.

Three Praxis II tests are required for Special Education Certification: Education of the Exceptional Students: Core Content Knowledge (#0353); Education of the Exceptional Students: Mild to Moderate (#0542); and Elementary Education Content Knowledge (#0014).
