Presidential Out-of-State Scholarship (For applicants to academic or technical programs)

Promising new non-resident students with a high school or transfer cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) will receive first consideration for this merit-based award. Returning and current students are not eligible. Students must be tentatively admitted by the priority deadline to receive first consideration (March 1 for Fall enrollment or November 1 for Spring enrollment). This scholarship is renewable for up to four years of consecutive attendance towards a Bachelor's degree and up to two years of consecutive attendance towards an Associate's degree based upon meeting the following requirements: maintaining a 2.5 semester GPA, completing at least 12 credits per semester, and registering for classes during advanced registration. Additional scholarships are available for students applying to technical majors: Mathematics with a minor in Information Systems, Chemistry, Computer Science, Pre-Engineering, Information Systems Analysis, Electronic Communications or Engineering Technology. These applicants must have a high school or transfer GPA of at least 3.2 on a 4.0 scale (at least 14 transferable semester credits). Priority is given to applicants who have not received a prior Bachelor's degree.
