Lewis-Clark State Rally's Around Women's Basketball Team and Haerling Family

The close-knit Lewis-Clark State College student body, faculty, staff and community were drawn together in sadness by the tragic news of the deaths of the grandfather and sister of junior guard Nikki Haerling. Haerling's Grandfather and Grandmother, Mother, Dad and sister were traveling to Lewiston for Saturday's game when the accident occurred outside of Moses Lake, WA. The Warrior Women's team was given the option of postponing or playing. The team decided to play. Warrior Assistant Women's Basketball coach, Scott Thompson said "It was a tough game for us to come and play. We met as a team before the game and decided that Nikki would want us to play, so we came and played the game... We want to say our thoughts and prayers are with Nikki and her family."

The Washington State Patrol reported that Don Haerling, 74 and Patricia Haerling, 14, were killed in the collision between the Haerlings van and a logging truck. The other three passengers- Lila Haerling, 71, Mike Haerling, 52, and Jean Haerling, 48- were airlifted to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle, where they were listed in serious condition.
