LCSC Spring Sports work towards National Tournaments

When spring arrives in the Lewis-Clark Valley, most residents think about the NAIA World Series, which takes place at the start of Memorial Day weekend in Lewiston. The top ten teams from all over the USA converge to choose the next national champion in NAIA Baseball. This year, LCSC's Men's and Women's Tennis and Golf teams, along with three members of the LC Track and Field program, are going to their respective national championships or are in contention to go.

In the most recent NAIA national standings, the Men's Tennis team is ranked # 21 and the Women are ranked # 10. Both teams will be in regional playoffs in Nampa April 25-26. Coach Kai Fong says both teams have a good

chance of making the trip to Nationals, held this year on May 16-20 in the Mobile Tennis Center in Mobile Alabama.

The LC Men's Golf team claimed the Region I Golf title at the recent tournament, held at the University of Idaho Golf Course the last week of April. By winning their regional tournament the Men's team receives an automatic bid to the national tournament, to be held May 24-27 at Olathe, Kansas at the Prairie Highlands Golf Course. The Men's team is currently ranked #17 nationally, and according to Coach Paul Thompson, will most likely move up in the polls due to their regional title. The Women's team is currently ranked #18 nationally, and will most likely receive an at-large bid to attend their national championship, to be held May 17-20 in South Bend, Indiana at the Blackthorn Golf Club. Nikki Olson came in 5th with a score of 240 and along with Jeff Thoeny of the Men's team was named to the All-Region Team.

While not well know, LCSC has a Track and Field program that competes in the spring. This year, senior Tausha Kuzmic has qualified for the NAIA Outdoor Track & Field Championships in the women's 10,000 meter race and in the marathon, a race she is hoping to win. Also qualifying for the marathon from LC are Pam Houston and Matt Solosabal. These championships will be held May 26-28 in Louisville, Kentucky.

Move out to the western US, and to northwestern Idaho, and you'll find the NAIA national baseball championships in Lewiston, Idaho May 27-June 3, 2005. The Warrior baseball team is currently ranked #1 nationally in the most recent NAIA poll. As of 04/27, the Warriors record is 37-6-0. With only 6 remaining home games, LC fans are gearing up to host over 250 student athletes, plus coaches, out-of-town family and friends, and over 500 local volunteers. The Warriors are on a 9-game winning streak and showing no signs of a slow entry into the series. NAIA World Series tickets are on sale on the 3rd floor of the new Activity Center, or can be purchased over the phone by calling 208-792-2471.
