## Warrior Sports Receive Positive National Ranking Information

Lewis-Clark State College athletic teams continue to receive national attention, whether it's the end of their season, or just the beginning.

The L-C women's cross country team lived up to its' national ranking by placing 19<sup>th</sup> at the NAIA national championships in Louisville, Kentucky on Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>. Taryn Joyce-Mendive paced the Warriors, finishing in 55<sup>th</sup> place in the 5-K race. Darrah Hocum also placed in the top 100 runners, finishing in 72<sup>nd</sup> place. The men's cross country team had only one runner at nationals, Ciprian Nitoi, who placed 157<sup>th</sup> in the 8-K race.

The final NAIA ratings for golf came out on Nov. 4<sup>th</sup> and gave the women's team a no. 15 national ranking and the men's team a no. 28. The golf team plays a split season schedule, with their spring season to begin on Feb. 13<sup>th</sup> at Clarkston Country Club. The next official rating will take place not until March 3, 2006.

One of L-C's volleyball players was honored with a selection to the 2<sup>nd</sup> team all-conference roster. Senior, Tyger Spencer of Lewiston received the selection due to her performance this past season notching 312 kills, averaging 3.32 per game and digging 213 balls over the 25 game season.

The Lewis-Clark State Warriors will begin the 2006 baseball season ranked no. 2. Oklahoma City, last year's 2005 NAIA national champions, who narrowly defeated the Warriors 11-10 in tournament play, will begin the year in the no. 1 spot.

Embry-Riddle, who knocked the Warriors out of the 2005 national tournament, starts the season at no. 3. The Warrior baseball season kicks off at home on February 10, 2006 against Vanguard University.

The L-C men's and women's basketball teams are currently in pre-season. The NAIA pre-season poll ranked the men at no. 27 and the women at no. 26 nationally. Thru Nov. 30<sup>th</sup> the men's win/loss record is 8-0 and the women's is 6-0.
