LCSC to Host State High School Volleyball Tourney

Watch some of the best in our state go head-to-head at the State High School Volleyball Tournament, scheduled for Thursday, Oct. 27-Saturday, Oct. 29th at the LC Activity Center and Lewiston High School. A total of 24 teams will visit Lewiston; 16 1-A teams and 8 2-A teams. The Tournament will begin pool play on Thursday, with the 1-A teams playing at the LC Activity Center on two courts and the 2-A teams playing at Lewiston High School. On Friday & Saturday both the 1-A and the 2-A teams matches will take place at the Activity Center.

Tennis Sends Two Athletes to the Wilson ITA Nationals

LCSC continues to excel in the athletic national arena with the announcement that two of its tennis athletes will be competing at the Wilson ITA National Small College Tennis Championships in Fort Meyers, Florida on October 13-16, 2005. Maria Resende, a sophomore from Uberaba, Brazil will compete in the singles and doubles. Maria's doubles partner is junior Khaluin Enkhjargal, of Ulaan-Baatar, Mongolia. Both qualified for this national tournament by winning in singles and doubles at the 2005 regional tournament, held September 30-October 1st at LCSC. The host school for the national tournament is Florida Gulf Coast University. There will be representation from NCAA Div. II, NCAA Div. III, NAIA and Junior College Teams. LC's Pei Yuin Keng and Hephzi Segura were the last Pacific Northwest representatives to the national tournament in 2003, where Pei took second in singles and third in doubles.
