It's almost time for the LC Men's and Women's Basketball teams to take to the hardwood! The men's team begins action on Friday, Oct. 26th at 8:00pm at Clarkston High School against Malaspina University, with a second game against the same school on Saturday, Oct. 27th at 2:00pm, also at Clarkston High School. These games are being played at CHS due to the State Volleyball Tournament being held in the Activity Center beginning on Thursday, Oct. 25th. The men begin their home games on Friday, Nov. 2nd in the Cannon's Building Materials Center Tournament. Then, the men take to the road for an exhibition game against Washington State University on Sunday, Nov. 4th at 4:00pm. Two of L-C's 15-passenger vans have been reserved to make the trip up to WSU. There will be no cost to ride the vans and since this is an exhibition game, there is no cost to get into the game. Please call the Athletic Development Office at 208-792-2692 if you would like one of these limited seats in the vans. A final count of riders will be needed by Wed. Oct. 31st.

The women's team also opens their season with games to be held at Clarkston High School. They will take on the Univ. of British Columbia-Okanagan on Fri. Oct. 26th at 6:00pm, and then play them again at CHS on Sat. Oct. 27th at 12:00pm. The women then take to the road for games against Boise State University on Nov. 4, Azusa Pacific on Nov. 9 and Hope International University on Nov. 10th. The women will then play in the Staples Classic on Fri. Nov. 16th and Sat. Nov. 17th, both at 6:00pm in the Activity Center. The women then take on Whitworth University in Spokane on Tues., Nov. 20th at 7:00pm. A Wheatland Coach has been arranged to take 43 people to this game. The bus will leave L-C at 4:30pm and return immediately following the game. Cost to ride the bus and get into the game is \$30/person. Please call the Athletic Development Office at 792-2692 by Tues.
