# The Activity Center

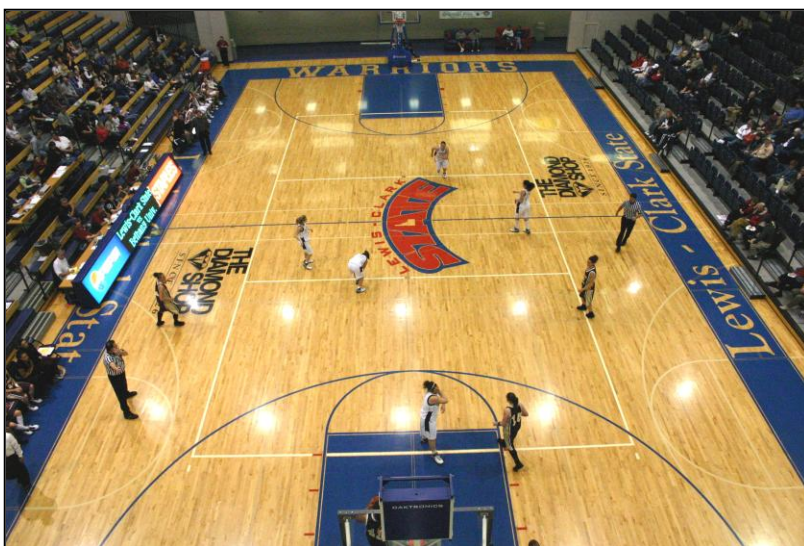
Officially Opened in January of 2005, the Activity Center adds to the region's excellence in sports venues, and offers the Lewis-Clark valley the opportunity to experience Warrior sports in a more exciting and comfortable atmosphere. The facility includes three full size basketball courts, and seating for over 3,500. The tri-level, 100,000 square foot facility includes classrooms, dance and exercise studios, study areas, athletic trainers' facilities, offices, and many other multi-purpose areas. The 15 million dollar Activity Center has quickly become the centerpiece of a growing Lewis-Clark State College.

A view from east side of the court



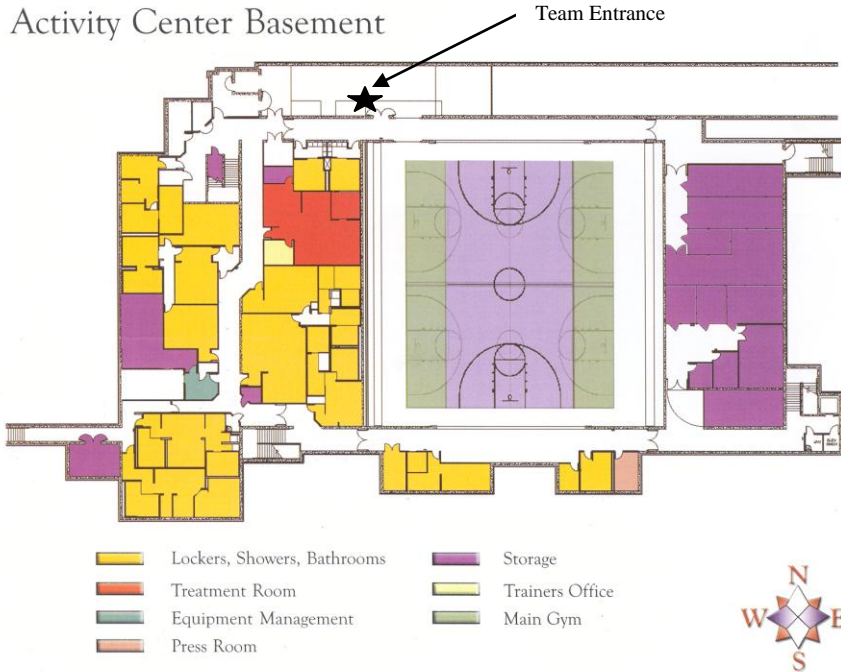

**Directions:** Located at the center of the college campus on the east side, the Activity Center's main doors stand at the corner of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue directly adjacent to Harris Field in Lewiston. Team vehicles are welcome to unload at the front gate, but are asked to park at the parking lot located on the corner of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue just south of Harris Field and the Activity Center. 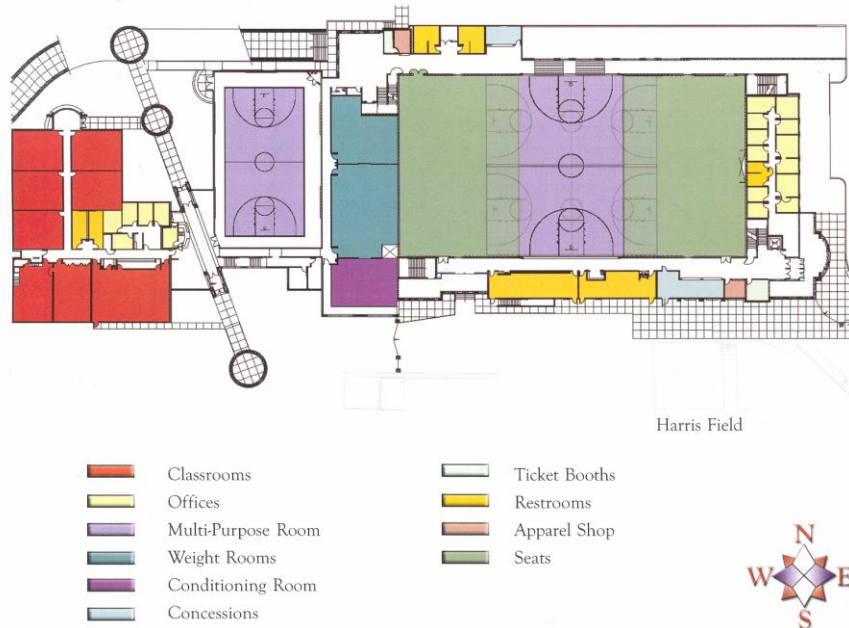

# Harris Field

---

Harris Field has been home to one of the most accomplished collegiate teams in the history of baseball, and to some of the most memorable moments in the history of the NAIA World Series. After years of baseball being played in cow pastures and back yards, Harris Field, slowly evolving and improving through the efforts of players, coaches, and volunteers, began to take its current shape in the 1970s. It was named after a prominent Lewiston business man and baseball enthusiast of the 1930s, Loyd Harris. Harris, known as “Mr. Baseball”, is one of the main reasons Lewiston has become the baseball town that it is today.

Although it has an official seating capacity of only 5,000, Harris Field has seen crowds exceed this total on multiple occasions. In 2008, the 52<sup>nd</sup> annual NAIA World Series brought a record crowd of 5,530 to Harris Field to watch the Warriors defeat Lee University 5-1 and win their 16<sup>th</sup> national title.

An experienced grounds crew and game management staff help keep Harris looking good all year round. From the rainy spring games in February to the beautiful NAIA World Series games in late May, Harris Field and the easygoing small town atmosphere of the Lewis-Clark valley give baseball fans a pleasant and memorable experience.

**Directions:** Directly adjacent to the Activity Center, Harris Field sits on the corner of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and official address is 500 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Teams are suggested to unload at the front gate located next to the Activity Center’s front doors and marked by an overhanging Harris Field banner.

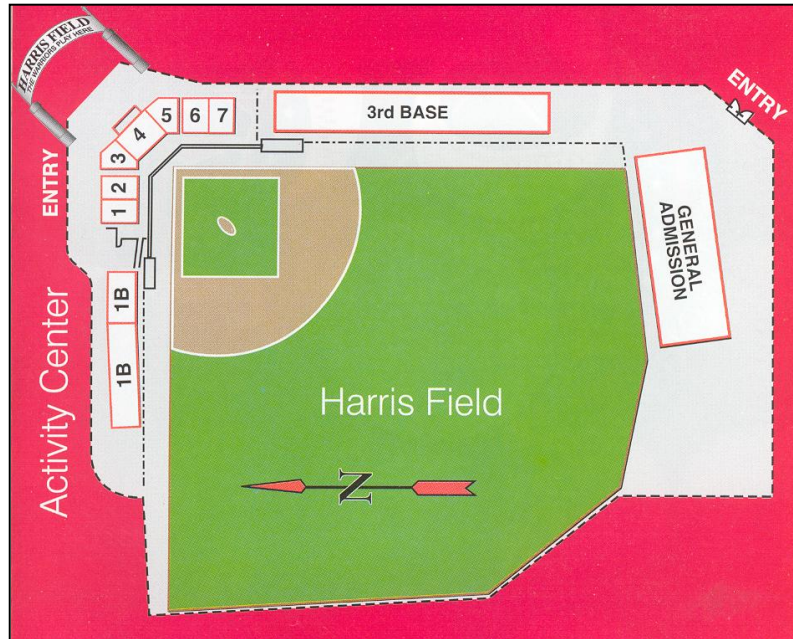

# Harris Field

**The Field:** Harris Field presents a standard dirt and grass field, with a grass outfield and wooden homerun fence. As a standard, the visiting team will be designated the first base dugout.

**Field Dimensions:**

Left Field Lane: 335 ft.  
Left Field Alley: 364 ft.  
Center Field: 372 ft.  
Right Center Field: 350 ft.  
Right Field: 335 ft.

**Harris Field Ground Rules:**

1. A thrown ball can get lodged in or behind the padding behind home plate. If this occurs the ball is dead.
2. A thrown ball can rest on top of the padding behind home plate. The ball is live and in play. A batted ball that touches that touches the backstop netting is dead.
3. If a ball gets through the netting behind home plate the ball is dead.
4. The ball is dead if it gets through a gap at either end of the backstop netting by the support poles.
5. The support poles of the backstop netting near the camera wells are out of play. Any live ball that touches both net and support pole is immediately dead.
6. The camera wells at the home plate end of both dugouts are out of play. A demarcation line will define the out of play area. If a ball enters this area, the ball is dead.
7. The concrete floor of the dugout, across the entire width of the dugout (including the vertical wall at each end) are dead ball areas. The lip of the concrete floor and the top uppermost facing of the dugout roof are live. A ball that breaks the plane of the concrete lip is dead. (Continued on page 8)

---

## Harris Field Ground Rules Continued:

8. All game personnel, with the exceptions of up to two (2) on deck batters, and all playing equipment must be kept inside the dugout at all times.
9. Electrical boxes/outlets on the ends of the dugouts are live.
10. The steel fence post and fencing along the ends of the dugouts are live.
11. All gates (at each end of the dugouts and down the right field line) must remain closed during play.
12. Any live ball that lodges in the banner affixed to the fences along each foul line will be ruled as a dead ball.
13. The tarp:
  - a. Live balls that go behind, into the tube, or break the demarcation line at either end of the tarp will be ruled as a dead ball
  - b. A player may not climb or stand on the tarp to extend the playing field. However, it is permissible to lean against the tarp: it is not permissible to stand on or kneel on the tarp to make a play happen.
14. Outfield fence:
  - a. Any fair-batted ball hit above the ten (10) foot outfield fence is immediately dead and ruled a double. Therefore, any bounding ball hitting the second row of signs above this fence, the scoreboard (including the protruding metal catwalk/stand); message center hitting eye in center field; etc. is a dead ball and ruled a double.
  - b. Please note there is not screen on the left field foul pole.
15. Any fair-batted ball or thrown ball that is:
  - a. Lodged in the shrubbery near the right field bullpen is dead.
  - b. Breaks the demarcation line in the opening of the fence down the right field line is dead.
  - c. Any live ball that hits the protruding grandstand in the right side foul territory is immediately dead.

# Warrior Tennis

---

Tennis has been a part of Lewis-Clark State College since as early as 1910, Warrior tennis as a collegiate program did not take shape until the late 1970s. Today the program stands as one of the best in the NAIA, and holds an impressive number of both regional and national titles.

**Tennis Center:** The nationally ranked program plays on one of the finest player's courts in the northwest. Built in 1975, Lewis-Clark State College's Tennis Center is a four-court indoor facility that within the last six years has undergone immense upgrading and remodeling. Improvements include an extensive resurfacing, a new roof, and an upgraded lighting system. Because of location and the facilities quality, the Tennis Center hosts a number of collegiate events including matches featuring prominent NCAA Division I programs. The Tennis Center and LCSC program serves both the community and the collegiate northwest year-round, and draws players from all around the world.

# Map of Lewiston & Driving Directions

## Driving Directions to LCSC

### **From the west on US Highway 12 (Walla Walla, Tri-Cities, etc.)**

You need to be in the right lane as you cross the Interstate Bridge over the Snake River from Clarkston to Lewiston.

Take a sharp right off the bridge. This is Snake River Avenue.

Continue for 0.8 Miles. Turn left on 11th Avenue.

Turn left on 6th street. You will see the baseball field.

Go straight until you see the parking lots on your right.

### **From the North/Northwest on US Highway 95/195 (Moscow, Pullman, etc.)**

US Highway 195 goes south from Spokane, WA through Colfax and Pullman, WA. US Highway 95 goes south from Coeur d'Alene, ID through Moscow. Highway 195 becomes Highway 95 approximately 6 miles north of Lewiston, ID.

Proceed south on US Highway 95 into Lewiston, staying to your right at the bottom of the hill and merging on US Highway 12 West into Lewiston, crossing the Clearwater River on Memorial Bridge.

Just past the bridge, US Highway 12 will turn to the right. Stay in the left lane, and take a left turn at the light onto 21st Street/Thain Road.

Proceed south on 21st Street/Thain Road until you come to 11th Avenue.

Turn right on 11th Avenue, and proceed on 11th Avenue until you come to the intersection of 11th Avenue and 6th Street.

You are now at Lewis-Clark State College's southeast corner.

### **From the South/East on US Highway 95 (Boise & Grangeville) and US Highway 12 (Orofino & Missoula, MT)**

You need to be in the left lane as you cross the Memorial Bridge over the Clearwater River into Lewiston.

Go through the first light you encounter. You should be on 21st Street.

Turn right onto 11th Avenue. Albertsons Grocery Store will be on your right at this intersection.

Follow until 6th street and take a right. You will see the baseball field.

There will be parking lots on your right and the campus will be on your left.

### **From Lewiston Nez Perce County Airport**

Leaving the Parking Lot of the airport, turn left onto Bryden Canyon Road.

At the first major intersection, take the exit to your right onto 8<sup>th</sup> Street from Bryden Canyon Road.

Turn right on 8<sup>th</sup> Street, and follow 8<sup>th</sup> Street all the way until you come to 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Turn left on 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and proceed 2 blocks to 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

You are now at Lewis-Clark State College's southeast corner. The main college is bordered by 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue on the North, 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue on the South, 4<sup>th</sup> Street on the West, and 6<sup>th</sup> Street on the East.
