LEVELS & BENEFITS

ABOUT THE COACH – For three consecutive seasons, the L-C Warriors have claimed the Frontier Conference title and head coach *Brian Orr* has earned three straight conference *Coach of the Year* awards. As he enters his 8th season, Orr has accumulated an overall record of 177-57 (.756) the best. His 25.3 wins per season is the highest in the history of the program. Under Orr, LCSC has a conference record of 78-20 (.796) and an impressive 98-14 (.875) home record; both are program highs. Before coming to L-C, Orr was the top assistant at Montana State University. Brian also spent 3 seasons as an assistant at Montana State University-Billings. He helped lead the Yellowjackets to three straight trips to the National Tournament and one trip to the "Elite Eight". From 1991-1996, Orr was the head boy's basketball coach at Fergus High in Lewistown, MT, where he was named the school's *Teacher of the Year* in 1996. He also served as both the head boy's and head girl's coach at Simms High School in Simms, MT, from 1986-91. In 1990, his girl's team won the Class B State Championship, and Brian was named *Coach of the Year* by the Montana Coaches Assoc. In 1989, he was honored by the Dufresne Foundation as the *Outstanding Educator of the Year*. In his 14-year high school coaching career, his teams won five conference titles and his girl's teams amassed a 101-39 (.721) overall record.
