**ABOUT THE COACH** – For three consecutive seasons, the Warriors have claimed the Frontier Conference title and head coach Brian Orr has earned three straight conference Coach of the Year awards. As he enters his 8th season, Orr has accumulated an overall record of 177-57 (.756). His 25.3 wins per season is the highest in the history of the program. Under Orr, LCSC has a conference record of 78-20 (.796) and an impressive 98-14 (.875) home record; both are program highs. Before coming to L-C, Orr was the top assistant at Montana State University. Brian also spent 3 seasons as an assistant at Montana State University-Billings. He helped lead the Yellowjackets to three straight trips to the National Tournament and one trip to the “Elite Eight”. From 1991-1996, Orr was the head boy’s basketball coach at Fergus High in Lewistown, MT, where he was named the school’s Teacher of the Year in 1996. He also served as both the head boy’s and head girl’s coach at Simms High School in Simms, MT, from 1986-91. In 1990, his girls team won the Class B State Championship, and Brian was named Coach of the Year by the Montana Coaches Assoc. In 1989, he was honored by the Dufresne Foundation as the Outstanding Educator of the Year. In his 14-year career as a high school coach, his teams won five conference titles and his girls teams amassed a 101-39 (.721) overall record.
