The Lewis-Clark State College Undergraduate Student Research Excellence Journal

The *Lewis-Clark State College Undergraduate Student Research Excellence Journal* aims to enhance student academic achievement, professional development and award research excellence by providing the opportunity for students to publish their research with students, faculty, staff, stakeholders and the community through an online research journal forum.

Submissions to the *Lewis-Clark State College Undergraduate Student Research Excellence Journal* meet rigorous research and academic standards and are sponsored by the student's research advisor or major professor, or program designee.

General Requirements

Papers nominated for the *Lewis-Clark State College Undergraduate Student Research Excellence Journal* should represent excellent examples of research assignments. Papers must be original research performed by the student(s) listed as authoring the article approved by the Institutional Review Board at Lewis-Clark State College.

There is no length requirement, but the article must contain a bibliography and be in APA format or the accepted style of the student's major. Articles will be reproduced in the same format as the student submits them. Graphics can be included.

All submissions must be nominated and submitted in the required format (see nomination and Formatting Requirements).

Nomination Requirements

Submissions to the *Lewis-Clark State College Student Research Excellence Journal* must be nominated by the faculty research advisor or the sponsoring faculty as representing excellent student research. Please have the nominating and co-nominating research advisor/faculty sign the submission form after you have filled it out.

Electronic Format Requirements

Submissions should be completed in Word or WordPerfect electronic file format.

Your paper should be formatted with 1 inch margins.

Graphics should be embedded in files with printed graphics included in the correct place in the hard copy of the paper. Tables and charts constructed in the word processor should be fine as they are.

Submission Requirements

Submit one electronic copy to blchristenson@lcsc.edu and one hard copy of your paper (including hard copies of your graphics). Print and fill out the submission form and the student declaration checklist, and include both with your submission copies and IRB approval letter.
