- I. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Kate Bales at 6:15 p.m. ASLCSC *Coeur d'Alene* council members present: Kate Bales, Jacqueline Maurer, Jeff Wilson and Serena Worobel. Guests: Rocky Owens, and Heidi Wilkins
- II. The minutes from last month were accepted.
