

**ASLCSC *Coeur d'Alene***

- I. - II. There was a motion to approve January's minutes as presented. The motion was seconded and unanimously passed.
- III. Treasurer Rosa Mettler reported the current balance of the ASLCSC *Coeur d'Alene* budget at \$4,221.82
- IV. Activities update:
  1. The hockey game went well. Jim at the Chief's Hockey said that we could have the same deal again if we ever wanted to go to another hockey game. We sold 43 tickets. In the future we should try and coordinate a game at the same time with LCSC main campus.
  2. April 8<sup>th</sup> - Wild Walls climbing- \$16 for a 2 hour lesson and for all day climbing and rental.
  3. April 23 Mineral Ridge hike- meet at 2:00 at the base. Water and some sort of a snack will be provided by ASLCSC *Coeur d'Alene*.

- VI. There was a motion to approve the ASLCSC *Coeur d'Alene* Job Descriptions as presented. The motions was seconded and unanimously passed.
- VII. Student Survey: The survey helped us to find out what exactly the needs are for the students up here are. Andy Hanson w/ Student Services in Lewiston commissioned the council to conduct the survey and will pay them \$300.
- VIII. 2006-2007 Council Nominations:

  3. Another possibility is to have other students nominate another student.
  4. Since the ASLCSC was here, we brought up the fact that many of the students that attend LCSC-CdA are enrolled at LCSC and NIC, so it is hard for them to have the 8 credit mandatory amount to be a council member. ASLSC *Coeur d'Alene* requested from ASLCSC (Lewiston) if they would consider reducing the credit amount required to six rather than eight.
  5. ALS CSC will bring the credit amount for ASLCSC *Coeur d'Alene* member amount at their next meeting about possibility amending the bylaws.
  6. Postcards and e-mails will be sent out to everyone but graduating seniors.
- IX. ASLCSC (Lewiston) voting, how to get CdA students more aware/involved? Election dates are April 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>. Candidates will have bios in the Pathfinder and we will hang it up on the board in the lounge. We asked if they could send up posters, or filers, or anything else than they wanted us to hang up or pass out up here to get their name out.
- X. Old Business:
1. Credits for graduation- work moving forward to resolve students who don't get to graduate with honors. When all is said and done, these students will be awarded with honors on their final transcript and degree.
  2. What to name award for faculty/administration? When to present? – Will name it the Spirit Award and can be presented to faculty, adjunct faculty, and staff as well. Well be presented at graduation by Vice-Chairperson, Wendy Hunter.
- XI. New Business:
1. LCSC 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration, evening of Thursday, April 13. This will have local business people.
  2. John Hale Golf Tournament: John would like to have us to be at the 10<sup>th</sup> hole and take pictures and run them to 1 hour photo. Since not all of can commit to this, this might be a good activity for the new council members to be a part of.
