Art and Music Events Highlight Dogwood Festival Calendar this April

The Annual Dogwood Festival of the Lewis-Clark Valley offers 4 artistic or musical events as part of its standing Calendar of Events.

The Stephen Lyman Memorial Children's Art Exhibit presents two and three-dimensional artwork of students from regional elementary schools, in the Lewis-Clark State College (LCSC) Center for Arts & History, April 10 through 25, 2009. Admission is free to the public.

Micro-brew and wine enthusiasts can enjoy their choice of 7 tastes, from a carefully selected variety of offerings, in a souvenir wine glass at the 19th Annual Confluence Grape & Grain, April 17, 2009. Advance tickets are \$20, at-the-door tickets are \$25; ages 21 and older only.

Over 12,000 visitors are expected to attend Art Under the Elms on the LCSC Campus over April 24, 25 and 26, 2009. The 3-day event offers 100 juried artist booths, musical entertainment, family fun activities and a food court. 3-day admission is \$2 per person.

A definite don't miss, is Deana Carter, presented by IDAVEND Broadcasting, at the Dogwood Festival Concert. The concert takes place in the LCSC Activity Center, 8:00pm, April 25, 2009. Advance tickets, available through TicketsWest, are \$25 and \$35, at-the door tickets are \$30 and \$40.

The Seaport Quilters Guild Annual Festival of Quilts showcases over 200 quilts and offers a merchant's mall with artists demonstrations in the Charles Francis Adams High School Gym, April 25 and 26, 2009. Admission is \$3.
