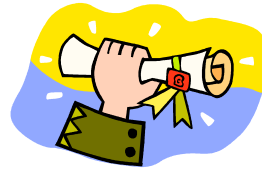

A look back at 2009-2010: CV ETS...

- Took 344 students on college campus visits
- Visited 5 colleges in Idaho
- Served 642 students in eight schools
- 95% advanced to next grade
- 96% graduated or received GED

- 100% of college-ready participants applied for college admissions
- 83% enrolled in college or technical schools the fall semester following graduation
