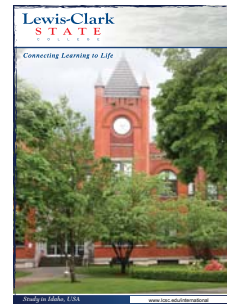

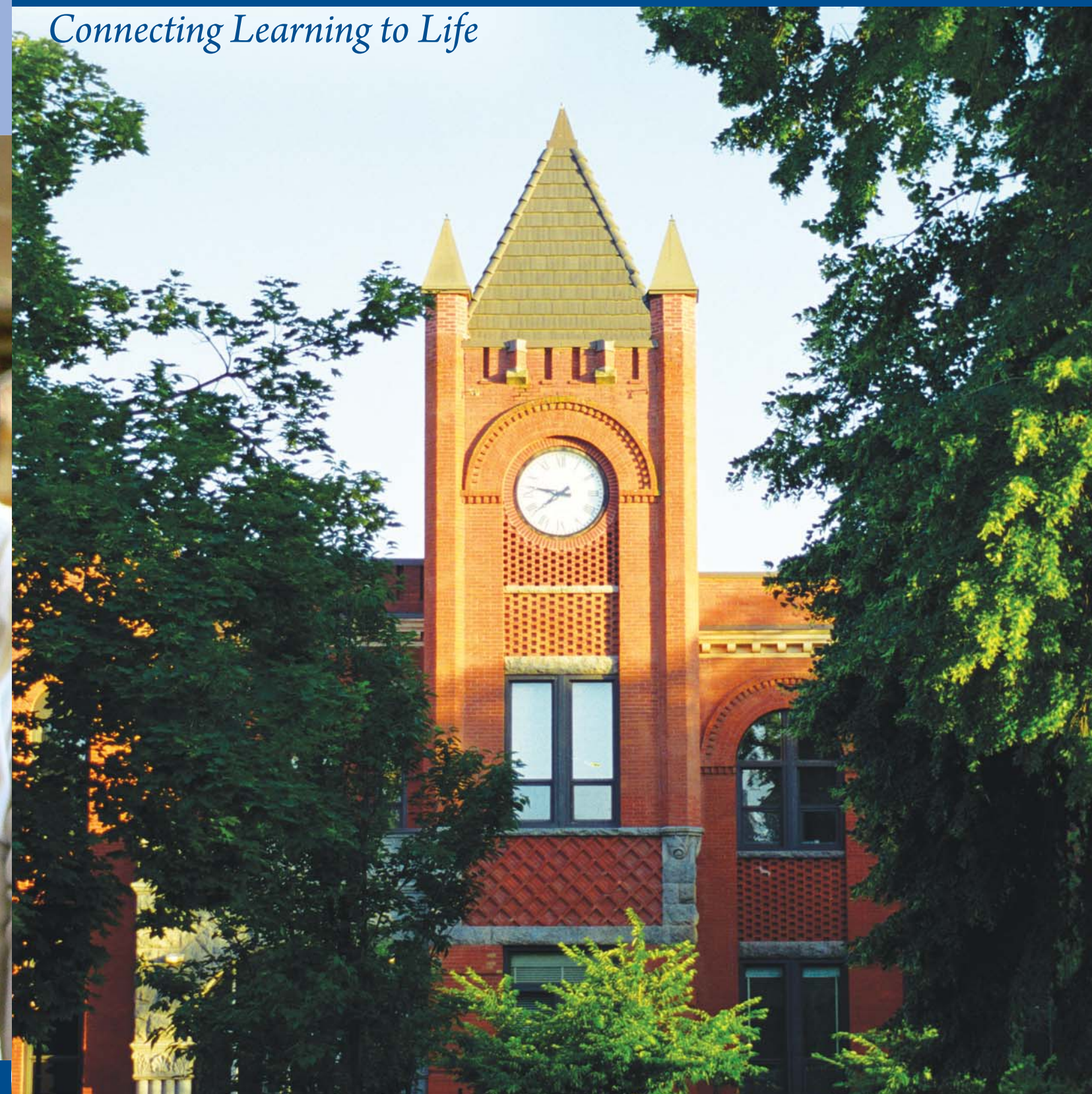

IIE has been teaching English language programs for over 25 years.

Many of our students have progressed onto LCSC college programs. The strengths of our program have been small classes, caring professional teachers who give individual attention, and the strong community interaction which includes our excellent Homestay program.

Program Structure:

We teach up to seven levels

- Classes are a maximum of 15 students (average size 7-10)
- Students are tested on their first day and placed in the appropriate level
- Core classes are:
 - Reading & Writing
 - Listening & Speaking
 - Grammar
 - Multi-Media Lab
- Elective classes include Business English, TOEFL preparation, conversation partners, idioms and slang, among others



Homestay:

Live with an American family, practice your English, and experience and learn about American culture & family life.

Includes:

- Private bedroom
- 3 meals a day
- Airport pick up
- Transport to and from college if more than 1 mile from campus.

*Students have the option of alternative accommodation - college residence halls or private rentals

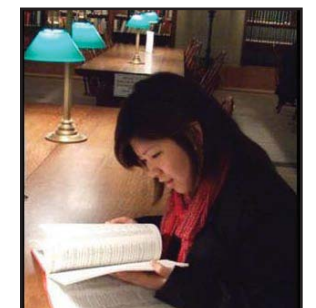
Community involvement and field trips:
