Types of Enrollment

1. English Language Program

LCSC offers English language training through the Institute of Intensive English (IIE). IIE caters to students who plan on studying college programs or who wish to upgrade their English language skills for personal and/or business reasons. IIE offers 6 eight-week terms throughout the year. Students may commence their studies in week 1 or week 5 of each term. Students are tested upon arrival and placed in the appropriate level (IIE offers 7 levels).

2. Conditional enrollment

LCSC offers conditional enrollment to students who need to improve their English language proficiency by studying at IIE so that they can meet LCSC English language requirements.

3. College programs

LCSC offers a wide range of Associate Degree and Bachelor Degree programs. Refer to page 4 for a list of popular programs.

Scholarships:

LCSC offers merit-based international scholarships. Students need to have at least a **3.0 GPA** to be eligible.

Priority Deadline for Scholarship Applications are March 1 (Fall) and October 1 (Spring). Late applications may be accepted.
