What is “information literacy?” *Information literacy* is the set of skills that enable you to find, evaluate, and use information to solve problems.

The Modules. The Library has developed some Information Literacy Modules to help you develop these skills with academic sources. You can work on the Information Literacy Modules anytime, from any computer with Internet access. The first module has an in-library activity to acquaint you with the physical space of the Library. All other modules are available for self-paced instruction online.

First, read through the tutorial on the Library’s Website. After completing the tutorial, take the online quiz. You may take the quiz as many times as you like; it will only keep your latest grade. When your instructor is ready to record your grade, he or she will find your latest quiz grade online.

To take the quiz, you must first login to Blackboard. Follow these steps:

<p>Open the LCSC Web site at http://www.lcsc.edu.</p> <p>Click on WarriorWeb.</p>	
<p>Click on ENTER.</p>	
<p>Click on Log In.</p>

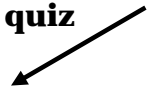
