

## Required Course Textbooks & Interlibrary Loan

Though we understand that textbook prices are especially high, the LCSC Library is unable to borrow required class textbooks via Interlibrary Loan. Why?

- Few libraries purchase textbooks. Textbook collections are usually reserved for campus-use only and are not loaned to other libraries.
- You would only get to keep a textbook borrowed through Interlibrary Loan for 2-3 weeks. Loan due dates are set by the lending library, not by the LCSC Library.

Failure to return items when due can lead to:

- You would be charged by the lending library for the full cost of the book PLUS a processing fee.
- Your access to Interlibrary Loan and all LCSC Library privileges would be suspended until the item is returned and/or any fees charged by the lending library are paid.
- Your grades, class registration, transcripts, and graduation would be blocked until the item is returned and/or any fees charged by the lending library are paid.
