PACE *Pathways for Accelerated Certification and Endorsement*

PACE enables students to earn teaching certificates and endorsements through distance-learning technology. The Elementary PACE program (**only available in North Idaho**) is for individuals who have completed an Associates Degree. The Secondary PACE program is for individuals who have completed a Bachelor's degree and wish to earn teacher certification as a post-baccalaureate. APPLY Admission Process

➤ Priority Deadline **March 1**

To ensure the greatest eligibility for federal aid and to qualify for LCSC scholarships, students must **submit scholarship applications and the FAFSA by the March 1 Priority Deadline**. Scholarship awards are based on academic merit, financial need, or a combination of both.

➤ Apply for **FREE**

Send in your application, apply in person, or online at www.lcsc.edu.

➤ Send Official College/University Transcripts

➤ Academic Students

Send in your high school transcripts and ACT or SAT test scores if transcript shows less than 14 transferable semester credits and under age 21.

➤ Professional-Technical Students

Send in your ACT, SAT, or COMPASS test scores if not transferring Math and English Composition.



TRANSFER 2015-2016 SCHOLARSHIPS

Do you meet these qualifications?

- Direct transfer to LCSC
- Have an Associate's degree from a college other than LCSC
- Plan to pursue a Bachelor's degree at LCSC
- Have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Plan on attending LCSC full time (12 or more credits per semester)

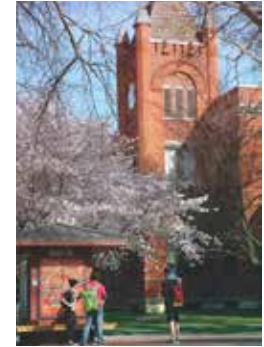
Starting spring semester? Apply for a transfer student scholarship by December 15!

TRANSFER CREDITS & CREDIT CONVERSION

There is no cap on the number of credits a student may transfer to LCSC. A minimum of 32 residential credits (at LCSC) must be completed for students to earn their degree.




Quarter credits are converted to semester credits by multiplying the quarter credits by .67. For example, five quarter credits equals 3.35 semester credits. ($5 \times .67 = 3.35$)

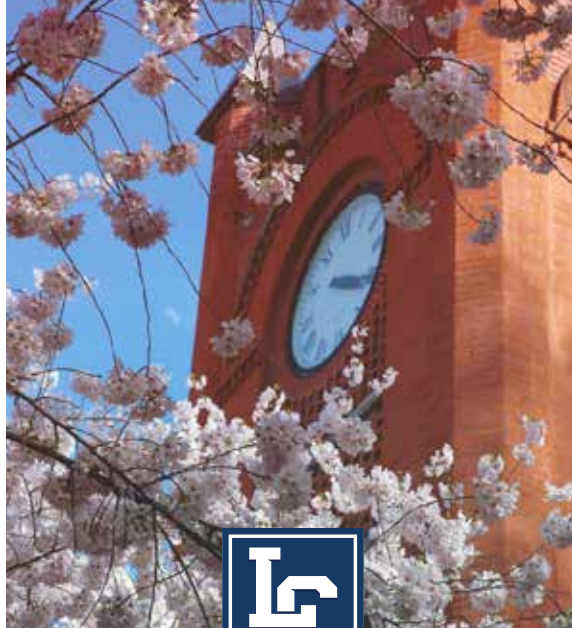
