Two awards –

- A woman from the LCSC Campus
 - A woman from the community – greater Lewis-Clark Valley
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- Exemplifies leadership in their field of expertise/ work place setting
 - Role model and/or mentor to other women and girls
 - Respected within the community
 - Gives back to the community or their profession through their time, talent and/or resources
 - Advocates for positive change that helps close the leadership gap and create a more equitable society for all
 - *Campus Only*: Demonstrates a commitment to the mission of LCSC and higher education

Nominations are vetted by LCSC Continuing Education staff. Finalists are presented to the awards selection committee, a panel of campus and community leaders for final selection.

5. Community Involvement: How has the nominee given back to the community through her time, talent, and /or resources? How has the nominee shown initiative or taken on a leadership role as a volunteer? (750 word limit).

6. State any other reasons why this nominee should be recognized as a Women of Leadership? (500 word limit).
