

## 5 Year Option

Many students prefer a curriculum plan that allows five (5) rather than (4) years to complete the BSN Program. For example, students in need of preparatory Math and/or English courses cannot complete all required coursework in less than 5 years. Other students, particularly those with heavy responsibilities at home or work may benefit from a lighter course load while completing prerequisites.
