SUBJECT: NON-SMOKING POLICY

In accordance with [Idaho Code § 39-5501 - 5511 Clean Indoor Air](#) and [Idaho Administrative Code, IDAPA 16.02.23](#), Lewis-Clark State College has adopted the following non-smoking policy.

1. Smoking tobacco or similar substances is not allowed **inside** any College-owned or operated building.
2. Smoking tobacco or similar substances is not allowed **outside** within 20-feet of all entrances and exits of campus buildings and facilities.
3. In accordance with [Idaho Code § 39-5507](#), any person who refuses to either extinguish the lighted tobacco product or leave the premises is guilty of an infraction and is subject to a fine not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50). Violations may be reported directly to law enforcement.
