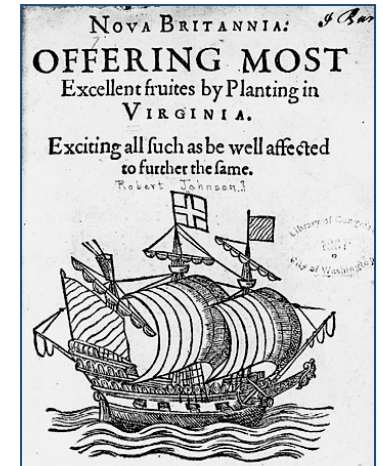
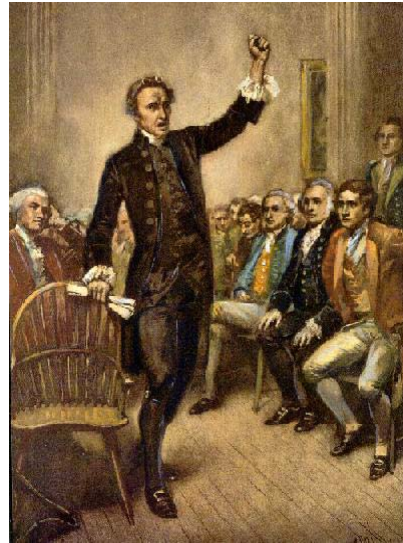

HISTORY 492: Early America, Pre-Contact through Revolution
Mondays from 3-5:30 pm Prof. Amy Canfield



This class will examine the history of North America from pre-contact through the American Revolution. Specific areas of interest will be the cultural exchanges between different groups (American Indian nations, Africans, and the Spanish, French, and English settlers); the impact of European empires on North America (with particular attention to Britain's rise to dominance on the continent); the development of colonial culture; and the roads to revolution within the British colonies.

This course will be a blend of lecture and discussion. Students will also complete a research paper on some component of Early American history.
