


Note: Students not meeting registration age requirements in their 10th grade year may register for AMFTI 141 and AMFTI 143 jointly their 11th grade year.

- complete a Division of Professional-Technical Education approved secondary sequence of courses
- meet 80% of competencies in each articulated course
- earn a grade of B or better in each course he/she articulates credit


- Students must meet all regular program admission requirements.
- Instructors from both the secondary and postsecondary program will review this articulation agreement annually. Changes in the agreement will be made only with the consent of both the secondary school and postsecondary institution.
- Credits earned in this program may transfer to other Idaho institutions. There may be a transcription fee for articulated credit.
- This TECH PREP articulation agreement will remain in effect until canceled by either party subject to the following: Notice Of Intent to discontinue must be presented by either party to the other and to the regional Tech Prep Coordinator before February 1. The Regional Tech Prep Coordinator will notify the State Division of Professional-Technical Education of the notice. If after renegotiation, an amended articulation cannot be reached, this agreement will terminate on July 1, one year after notice of termination is presented.


