


Is my program required to comply with the full requirements of LC State Policy 4.135: Minors on Campus?

* Programs will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis to determine the custody and control as defined in Policy 4.135



Typically Exempt from Policy 4.135 if:

Minors are accompanied by parent or legal guardian through out the duration of the event

Programs are open to the general public

Orientation, campus tour/visitation, and enrollment programs organized by LCSC

K-12 programs/activities using college-owned or controlled property (ie: science fairs, and supervised field trips)

To proceed, contact Events & Conferences to confirm proposed event is Exempt.

Comply with Policy 4.135 if:

LCSC assumes responsibility of custody and control of minors in the absence of their parent (s) and/or legal guardian(s)

Third-Party (non-LCSC) program/activity, held on campus, assumes responsibility of custody and control of minors in the absence of their parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s)
