



Be automatically considered for merit-based scholarships by submitting your application materials and being tentatively admitted (must have 7th semester or 10th trimester transcript on file) by the March 1 Priority **Deadline.** Additional scholarships are available through our Scholarship Portal and check out our website for outside scholarship opportunities.

The general scholarship application is separate from the admission application, incomplete and late applications will not be considered. ACT is composite score. SAT score is a combination of evidence-based reading and writing and math. To be colbased on ACT/SAT scores, students must have at least a 2.5 minimum GPA.

"Students must be tentatively admitted by March 1st to be considered for scholarships. "Students eligible for only one scholarship.


