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STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIPS – INFORMATION FOR RECOMMENDERS

Below you will find specific information about each of the scholarships that your student may be applying for and some general guidelines to consider when writing their recommendation.

Dr. Helen Bernfield Foreign Language Study Abroad Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was established by anonymous donors in honor of the late Dr. Helen Cannon Bernfield (1900-1996), a pioneering woman physician and specialist in the treatment of tuberculosis. It is an endowed scholarship managed by the LCSC Foundation, and the funds are to be used to offset expenses incurred by Lewis-Clark State College (LCSC) students who will go abroad to study a language currently offered at LCSC. The student must have at least a 2.75 GPA and be of sophomore standing. Preference will be granted to applicants who have completed two or more years of college-level instruction in the target language. In no case will a recipient of the scholarship have completed less than one year of college-level instruction in the target language.

Study Abroad Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was created in 1993 by faculty in the LCSC Humanities Division to offset the expenses of an LCSC student who plans to study a language in a foreign country. The student must have at least a 2.75 GPA and be of sophomore standing. Preference will be granted to applicants who have completed two or more years of college-level instruction in the target language. In no case will a recipient of the scholarship have completed less than one year of college-level instruction in the target language.

Additional Consideration for Recommenders

Studying away bears not only the usual challenges of balancing academic and personal affairs that accompany college life, but also the added challenge of living in and navigating a foreign culture and language. In addition to commenting on how the experience will influence or benefit the student and their future goals, please also comment on the applicant's general preparedness, academically and personally, for study abroad. You may consider any factors that you think may have a bearing on the applicant's successful experience in the desired study abroad program. These factors might include motivation, flexibility, tolerance, resilience, determination, responsibility, and so forth.

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
