COURSE DESCRIPTION:

To further develop their knowledge and skill in the study and teaching of Life-span development psychology, the direct study student will essentially fulfil the role of an Undergraduate Teaching Assistant for two sections of Life-span Development Psychology (205-01 & 205-02).
