**Office 365 License Upgrade:** LC State has updated its annual subscription for its Microsoft Office licensing. The college now has access to almost all Microsoft services without purchasing additional licensing. The expanded licensing contains many new advanced security functions and additional software services. The newly available software services include Microsoft Power Automate, Microsoft Power BI Professional, Microsoft Project, Microsoft Teams Phone, and Microsoft Visio. In addition, through your "@lcsc.edu" email account, you can download Microsoft Office and load it on up to five personal devices.

- Public Service Loan Forgiveness: Full-time, benefit-eligible employees may qualify for a
  program offering forgiveness on remaining balances of federal loans. LC State is a qualified
  employer for the <u>Public Service Loan Forgiveness program</u> and the program is providing a waiver
  opportunity through October where borrowers may receive credit for payments that have been
  suspended or deferred, or may receive credit for past periods of payments. The Human Resource

- IT Reorganization: Over the past year, the Information Technology Services department has experienced significant changes, with six individuals leaving the team. After multiple conversations with members of the ITS Team, President Pemberton, President's Cabinet members, HR team, Budget Office, and many in the college community, we developed a new organization structure that will better meet the evolving needs of LC State. As part of the reorganization, we have updated and revised seven of the 17 job descriptions and created two

- **Parking Permits**: 2022-2023 parking permits are available and ready for purchase online at <a href="https://lewisclark.omnigo.one/CESIReportExec/opr">https://lewisclark.omnigo.one/CESIReportExec/opr</a>. Annual permits cost \$75 and semester permits cost \$50. Permits will be available for pickup in the Public Safety office, MLH 110, during regular business hours. You may park on campus without a permit until Monday, Aug. 29.
  - New 30-Day Permit: The Department of Public Safety is now offering the option to purchase a 30-day parking permit for \$25. To purchase a 30-day parking permit, visit <u>https://lewisclark.omnigo.one/CESIReportExec/opr/Main.aspx</u> and select this option.
     Once registration is complete, you will receive an email with your permit, including the date of expiration. It is your responsibility to print the permit and place it on the driver's side dashboard. Please contact the Department of Public Safety at 208-792-2226 with any questions.
