## Announcements

• Notifications: Based on information and guidance provided by the Lewiston Police Department (LPD), LC State issued a security notification Thursday morning, Nov. 17. In response, our campus safety protocol was initiated, the Warrior Alert communication system worked as designed, and the campus community was informed of our situational status via email, phone/text, social media, and our website. Additionally, as part of our ongoing campus safety efforts the Office of Public Safety (208-792-2815, security@lcsc.edu) has and continues to provide safety escort services, and our Counseling Center (208-792-2211, counseling@lcsc.edu)

has been and is available to support students. Faculty and staff, of course, may access the <u>Employee Assistant Program</u>. The below is provided to help inform the campus community regarding LC State campus safety protocols.

- Students may update their contact information at any time and are required to verify their phone numbers and mailing addresses every semester when they register for classes. They can also provide additional phone numbers for family members who may wish to receive emergency notifications (more information on this is below).
- As to general safety protocols, routine coordination with external agencies such as the local police and fire departments occurs for the specific purpose of ensuring that our responses to campus emergencies and even non-emergency events are managed effectively.
- Our <u>Emergency Response Plan</u> is reviewed and updated throughout the year as are related policies and procedures. The security of our campus and the safety of our campus community remain priorities at LC State.

Two of the most common questions that have come up recently relate to parents who wish to receive alerts and employees who reported not receiving alerts. Both questions are addressed below along with an overview regarding the Warrior Alert system.

- Warrior Alerts The Warrior Alert system is managed by LC State's offices of public safety and communications, with support from the IT department. All students and employees are automatically enrolled within the system which is updated automatically every day (note: opting in is not necessary for students and employees). The contact information within the system is wholly dependent upon what the student or employee has provided to the Registrar or Human Resources, respectively. Making changes to your contact information is to be handled through these offices and is addressed below.
- **Employees –** Employees who are not receiving notifications on their cell phones should email the correct phone number to <u>hr@lcsc.edu</u>. HR will then update your file. Employees can see what phone number is currently on file by viewing their WarriorWeb profile.
- Parents It is possible for parents to receive Warrior Alert notifications, however, it is dependent upon the contact information that a student provides. Students who wish to add a parent to the Warrior Alert system can do so by adding the parent's phone number to this <u>change of address form</u> and emailing it to <u>registrar@lcsc.edu</u>. - Tree Removal: The LC State Arboretum Committee wants to let the campus community know about some upcoming tree removals over winter break. The Arboretum Committee encourages tree retention or conservation whenever possible. However, as part of the natural process of aging and renewal, some trees decay and are at risk of falling. From time to time, dying or decaying trees are removed before they become a safety hazard. Ten Ash trees located along the roadway and parking east of Sacajawea Hall have been deemed a safety and welfare issue. All ten trees will need to be removed in the last few weeks of December 2022. In the spring of 2023, 10 trees will be planted in accordance with our tree replacement plan in our Tree Campus Higher Education standards with the Arbor Day Foundation. In the spirit of the location of these trees, adjacent to our Nursing & Health Sciences building, tree species are being selected that have historical significance in medicinal uses. Two members of the Arboretum Committee, Trent Morgan and Celeste Ellis, who are faculty in the Nursing & Health Sciences Division and serve on the Arboretum Committee are spearheading the process of species selection. The LC State Campus is a Level 1 Accredited Arboretum with ArbNet and the Morton Arboretum, as well as a Tree Campus Higher Education with the Arbor Day Foundation. The LC State Arboretum is home to over 1,000 trees. To learn more about our campus Arboretum, visit our LC State Arboretum Committee website. - Computer Lab and Classroom Software/Hardware Changes: The deadline to request changes for the upcoming spring semester is Dec. 12. Changes to the computer labs and instructor computers in the classrooms occur twice a year between semesters. Changes include adding additional software, moving computers, and installing new hardware (printers, desktops, laptops, AV systems, etc). Requests will be made by May 1 for the fall semester and Dec. 12 for the spring semester. Requests should be emailed to helpdesk@lcsc.edu by the deadline.
- Annual Student Survey: Students have been sent the annual Student Survey administered centrally by the Office of Institutional Research. Please encourage students to respond to this campus-wide survey. Responses will help us better support and serve our students. The survey will close today, Nov. 28, at 5 p.m.
- Staff Evaluations: The new CSO and PSO evaluation forms have been posted to the <u>HR</u> <u>website</u>, along with an <u>instructional video</u>. This year, the employee begins the process by completing sections I, II, and III of the <u>Non-Supervisory</u> or <u>Supervisory</u> Performance Evaluation and forwards it to their immediate supervisor, who will complete the remainder of the evaluation. Please review the employee's job description during this process. Email their job description (make sure it is on the new job description template) to <u>hr@lcsc.edu</u>. All staff performance evaluations are due Jan. 31, 2023.
