- Test of Emergency Notification System: On Friday, Dec. 9, at noon, the Department of Public Safety and Office of Communications & Marketing will conduct a test of the Warrior Alert System. The test message will be sent via email, text and phone. To ensure you receive the message by all modalities, please confirm your contact information is up to date. All students and employees are automatically enrolled within the system with the information provided upon enrollment (students) or employment (employees). The system is automatically updated every day and the contact information within the system is wholly dependent upon what the student or employee has provided to the Registrar or Human Resources, respectively. Making changes to your contact information is to be handled through these offices and is addressed below.
 - Employees Employees can see what phone number is currently on file by viewing their WarriorWeb profile. If changes are needed, send an email with the updated information to hr@lcsc.edu. HR will then update your file.
 - Students & Parents It is possible for parents to receive Warrior Alert notifications, however, it is dependent upon the contact information that a student provides. IT Outages:

College network systems will be serviced during the early mornings of Dec. 22 and 23 from 4-8 a.m. Please expect all network services on the college campus to be unavailable during those hours. Also, note that the outage may interrupt college phone service during the posted hours.

- All Ellucian Colleague services will be down beginning 8 a.m. on Wednesday, Dec. 28, and will not be restored until noon on Thursday. Dec. 29.
- Tree Removal: The LC State Arboretum Committee wants to let the campus community know about some upcoming tree removals over winter break. The Arboretum Committee encourages tree retention or conservation whenever possible. However, as part of the natural process of aging and renewal, some trees decay and are at risk of falling. From time to time, dying or decaying trees are removed before they become a safety hazard. Ten Ash trees located along the roadway and parking east of Sacajawea Hall have been deemed a safety and welfare issue. All ten trees will need to be removed in the last few weeks of December 2022. In the spring of 2023, 10 trees will be planted in accordance with our tree replacement plan in our Tree Campus Higher Education standards with the Arbor Day Foundation. In the spirit of the location of these trees, adjacent to our Nursing & Health Sciences building, tree species are being selected that have historical significance in medicinal uses. Two members of the Arboretum Committee, Trent Morgan and Celeste Ellis, who are faculty in the Nursing & Health Sciences Division and serve on the Arboretum Committee are spearheading the process of species selection. The LC State Campus is a Level 1 Accredited Arboretum with ArbNet and the Morton Arboretum, as well as a Tree Campus Higher Education with the Arbor Day Foundation.
