#### **President's Message**

Dear all,

As you may be aware, the higher education budget was defeated in the Idaho House of Representatives last week. The budget now goes back to JFAC (the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee) and will be revised and then rerouted through the Senate and House. Ultimately, legislatively approved budgets must be signed by the Governor (see how a bill becomes a law). Until a budget is passed we don't know what will be available for CEC (despite the broader state-level approval, each agency budget must be approved), and what legislatively approved operating funds we will have for next year. LC State was well positioned in the budget that failed. It is likely that our positioning will not be as favorable as revisions are made. It is also likely that there will be intent language attached to the budget that addresses legislative concerns associated with social justice issues. We do not yet know when JFAC will reconsider the higher education budget – maybe sometime this week (see: <a href="https://legislature.idaho.gov/lso/bpa/ifac">https://legislature.idaho.gov/lso/bpa/ifac</a>). The State Board of Education (SBOE) typically considers tuition/fee setting during its April meeting. Because of the delay in state budget setting, tuition/fees will not appear on the April 21-22 SBOE agenda. We do not yet know when the SBOE will take up the tuition/fee issue. The bottom line is that much remains unknown.

In other news as you can see from our COVID-19 dashboard, coronavirus protocols (face coverings, social distancing, enhanced cleaning, etc.) continue to help safeguard our campus community. I know we are all tired of living protocol-compliant lives. It is tedious, frustrating and even maddening at times. That said, stay the course Warriors. We are almost there – just two weeks until our LC State 2021 Spring Break!

I will close by personally thanking all who took advantage of our LC State – Public Health vaccine clinics these past two Fridays; as well as those who have already taken advantage of vaccine availability as per their eligibility (see below for ongoing vaccine availability). The less virus hosts available, the less chance for contagion spread and virus mutation; and the sooner we get our lives back.

- **Registrar Position:** Ted Unzicker has been named LC State's registrar and began his position on April 5. He previously served as assistant registrar at the University of Idaho. Prior to this, he enjoyed a 25-year career in the U.S. Air Force and three of those years were spent as the department chair in Aerospace Studies for the University of Idaho and Washington State University.
- **Recruitment at LC State:** The Admissions Office is offering four segments on recruitment and enrollment. Here's the third installment:
  - After a student navigates the prospect/inquiry stage, the student enters the applicant stage. The steps to apply for admission are showcased in all official marketing pieces and mentioned in emails, postcards/letters, and texts/phone calls. Students have the option of applying online or submitting a paper application. Idaho high school seniors can apply using the State Board of Education's Apply Idaho application. This application allows students to apply to as many Idaho institutions as desired. To help students move to the admit phase, the Admissions Office contacts them about additional documentation needed for their file. Admissions communicates via physical mailings, emails, phone calls, and texts. Once all documents have been received and the application file is complete, admissions evaluates the student's file for tentative or full admission. Once admitted, the handoff to the Advising Center and divisions occur.
- Professional Clothing Closet: LC State students are getting great use of the Professional Clothing Closet and more donations are needed. The LC State Student Employment & Career Center is in need of men's and women's suits. Clothing currently accepted includes: full suits, suit jackets, slacks, professional shirts/blouses, professional skirts. Professional women's plus size attire is in high need.
