Dear all,

I want to extend a HUGE thank you to our campus community, athletic department, our tournament title sponsor Avista, our major sponsors and honorary coaches, and the 100s of volunteers who, together, made the Avista NAIA World Series baseball tournament a terrific success. To quote one of the Series team coaches, it was "an electrifying celebration" of athleticism and community. What a wonderful way to cap off an incredibly challenging year.

In a year when many schools across the country didn't hold live/in-person instruction (as we did), all of our LC State sports programs engaged in full seasons of competition and achieved both in the classroom and on the court/field. Forty student-athletes earned a GPA between 3.0-3.49, 66 had a GPA between 3.5-3.99, and 32 achieved a perfect 4.0. That translates to 70% of our **student-athletes** earning 3.0 or better GPAs! Twenty-six student-athletes earned All-American status, and numerous were all-conference honorees. LC State boasted conference championships in men's basketball, women's basketball, men's cross country and baseball, and qualified for nationals in cross country, track and field, basketball, golf, and baseball, and had a national champion in the javelin (Leon Menten).

All of this is truly a reflection of indomitable Warrior tenacity and grit. Congratulations to LC State athletics, our student-athletes, and coaches. We are proud of you.

Finally, I thought the photos below might bring a smile to folks' faces. Fall 2019 I donned a University of Idaho shirt, showing my Vandal spirit and supporting my friend and colleague UI President C. Scott Green at a football game. Spring 2021 Scott suited up displaying Warrior pride and joined me for the Series opening night. Side-by-side, we are serving and supporting Idaho students and communities.

- **Coronavirus Updates & Risk Level:** For the latest coronavirus updates and information visit <u>www.lcsc.edu/coronavirus</u>. In accordance with its <u>Operational Levels</u>, LC State's current risk level is: Minimal.
  - Cases Update: Currently there are no active cases and no students in isolation in campus housing. The college has had 29 confirmed cases this spring. Note: Of those 29, only three were resident students (two in January and one later in the spring). The total college numbers reflect students and employees, full-time/part-time, online and face-to-face across all LC locations (i.e., Coeur d'Alene, Grangeville, Orofino, and Boise). This makes our low numbers all the more impressive and the campus community commitment to science and safety a point of pride worth crowing about! President Pemberton

  - LC State protocols: Ongoing protocol decisions will continue to be guided by science and safety, with summer modifications (see <u>Summer 2021 Outlook</u>) in effect May 17-Aug.
