- **Coronavirus Updates & Risk Level:** For the latest coronavirus updates and information visit <u>www.lcsc.edu/coronavirus</u>. The page will continue to be updated with resources and FAQs. In accordance with its <u>Operational Levels</u>, LC State's current risk level is: Minimal.
 - Campus Notifications: Campus notifications regarding self-reported and confirmed cases of coronavirus will be handled on a case-by-case basis in accordance with guidance from Idaho Public Health. Individuals directly impacted by a case or possible case will be contacted directly.

- Travel Guidelines: Updated travel guidelines are now available. <u>View fall 2020 travel</u> <u>guidelines</u>. With Labor Day weekend coming up, employees are asked to be mindful of the guidelines to ensure we can return to campus as smoothly as we started the semester.
- Locker Rooms: As a safety measure, all locker rooms have been taken offline for nonathletes at this time. Update: Faculty/staff lockers rooms will not be taken offline, however, changing areas will have a maximum capacity of four people at one time, and showers will be offline until further notice.
- Face Coverings: Just a reminder that LC State requires all faculty, staff, students and campus visitors, at all its locations, to wear a face covering when inside buildings, and also outside when social distancing cannot be maintained. Update: The CDC and local public health officials, do not recognize plastic face shields or plexiglass barriers as adequate substitutes for a cloth or disposable face covering.
