- **Coronavirus Updates & Risk Level:** For the latest coronavirus updates and information visit <u>www.lcsc.edu/coronavirus</u>. The page will continue to be updated with resources and FAQs. In accordance with its <u>Operational Levels</u>, LC State's current risk level is: Minimal.
  - Cases Update: The college has had four confirmed cases this fall. Currently there
    is one active case and no students in isolation in campus housing. For the latest
    numbers visit the coronavirus webpage.
  - Face Coverings: [Updated Sept. 8] LC State requires all faculty, staff, students, and campus visitors, at all its locations, to wear a face covering when inside buildings, and also outside when social distancing cannot be maintained. The effectiveness of face shields continues to be evaluated by the CDC. As such, LC State will approve the use of face shields only under special circumstances. Though students and employees are expected to provide their own, face coverings will be provided to guests who do not have

- Warrior Wellness Pledge: <u>Employees can view and sign the Pledge here</u>. Students will access the Pledge through WarriorWeb. Update: Over 2,000 students and 400 employees (92%) have already signed the pledge. Thank you!
- Air Quality Advisory: While Lewiston air quality conditions remain in the category of "unhealthy" or worse, the following advisory will remain in place for LC State's Lewiston campus: Due to air quality conditions, students, faculty and staff who have underlying medical conditions are allowed to engage remote work and/or instruction based on their judgment regarding health issues and concerns. Supervisors are instructed to accommodate remote work as needed. Individuals with heart or lung conditions and older adults should avoid outdoor physical activity.
