

- Coronavirus Updates & Risk Level: For the latest coronavirus updates and information
  visit <a href="www.lcsc.edu/coronavirus">www.lcsc.edu/coronavirus</a>. The page will continue to be updated with resources and FAQs.
  In accordance with its Operational <a href="Levels">Levels</a>, LC State's current risk level is: Minimal.
  - Cases Update: Currently there are six active cases and no students in isolation in campus housing. The college has had 12 confirmed cases this fall. For the latest numbers visit the coronavirus webpage. Risk level change: Because there are now zero students in isolation in campus housing, the designated campus risk level has changed from moderate to minimal, per LC State's Operational Levels Matrix.
  - Spring Schedule: Considerations associated with spring 2021 operations are underway. Please be reminded that the Instructional Plan (found on the coronavirus webpage and shared beginning mid-summer) noted that LC State anticipated classes to start Jan. 19, 2021, as scheduled; and that although preparations for the possibility of a remote start were advised, "A final determination [would] be made in fall semester." In other words, a remote start was not and is not a sure thing. In order to allow maximum planning and preparation time, LC State anticipates a determination in this regard, as well as other possible modifications, will be finalized and communicated by Monday, Oct. 5, 2020.
  - o Catering/Food: The Catering/Small Group Gathering Guidelines have been updated.
  - o Events: The Events & Conferences Guidelines have been updated.
- Budget Director: Assistant Budget Director Cindy Patterson has been selected as LC State's
  new budget director, Vice President for Finance and Administration Julie Crea announced on
  Monday. Patterson has served in her current role for four years and in the Budget Office since
  2007. She graduated from LC State in 2000 and worked in public accounting, doing bookkeeping,

auditing, tax and financial statement preparation, for six and a half years before being hired by LC State. Patterson is very active across campus and is in her second year as chair of the Professional Staff Organization.

- VPN Users: IT recommends that you test your VPN connection at least once a month to make sure it works and that you receive all necessary updates. Contact the IT Help Desk for more information.
- Pathfinder App: The Pathfinder can now be accessed by searching for the "College News Source" App in both the <a href="Apple App Store">Apple App Store</a> and the <a href="Google Play Store">Google Play Store</a>. Once you download the College News Source App, open the app and start by searching "Pathfinder" or "Lewis-Clark State College". You will receive push notifications for important events, such as the Career Fair, and updates when stories are published to the site.
- **Phishing:** LC State has been made aware of a "large-scale, highly sophisticated" nationwide phishing campaign. Here's a quick reminder about how to avoid phishing scams:
  - o Never respond to or open up attachments from unsolicited or unknown email senders.
  - Always verify the sender is someone you know and that their return email address matches the sender information.
  - When possible, contact the sender directly if you still have doubts about the validity of the email or attachments and directions inside the email.
  - o Please report any suspicious emails or phone calls to the Help Desk or to <a href="mailto:phish@lcsc.edu">phish@lcsc.edu</a>.
- **Phone Upgrade:** IT will be upgrading LC State's telephone connection to campus. Once upgraded, the campus will be able to take advantage of new features such as Enhanced 911. The installation of a new fiber connection, which will replace existing copper lines, will start on Thursday, Oct. 1.
- Microsoft Office Upgrade: All campus Windows PCs will be automatically upgraded to Microsoft Office 2019 the week of Oct. 5. This is necessary because Office 2016 will no longer be supported starting Oct. 13. Information Technology will send out additional information about the automatic upgrade process on Oct. 5. If you wish to upgrade early on your own, follow the steps outlined here. Note: this process can take 10-30 minutes to complete and you must be on campus. If you use OneNote, please contact the Help Desk before you perform the upgrade. OneNote 2019 requires you to store your files on OneDrive The Help Desk can assist you in moving your files.
- Travel Guidelines: The recently updated travel guidelines and an attestation form have been
  added to the <u>SafeColleges Training website</u>. Employees should have received an email from
  SafeColleges on Friday (check your "clutter" folder). The guidelines must be reviewed and the
  attestation form signed by Oct. 2.
- Schweitzer CTE Center Construction: "We are closing in on the final days of the construction contract. The building will be "turned over" to LC State in the very near future. It is exciting to see it all come together. You will notice all the "stuff" in the new auto shop pictured below.
