- Annual UAR & RRF: It's the season for annual Unit Assessment Reports (UAR) and Resource Request Forms (RRF) for FY25. As usual, any resource requests should be tied to program assessment (i.e., measurable program outcomes & self-sustainability), the college's Mission and Strategic Plan as well as the Presidential Priorities of enrollment and retention, and streamlining operations. Unit assessment (in coordination with supervisor) and resource request documents should be prepared by program directors and academic chairs and submitted for supervisor review by **Dec. 1, 2023**. Unit Assessment Reports are to be submitted at least every three years, on a rotation determined by the unit, so please consult with your supervisor. Then these documents will be posted to our campus-wide program assessment website, and Functional Area Committees (FACs) chaired by the area Vice Presidents or designee(s) will review Resource Request Forms between January-February to discuss and prioritize items. Emergent priorities will be presented to the President's Executive Cabinet between February-March. The full timeline, forms, and guidance can be found here. New this year, visualize "Shark Tank"...
