- Payroll Updates:

- Social Security Wage Base The Social Security wage base (SSDI) for calendar year 2024 will increase from \$160,200 to \$168,600. The tax rate remains 6.2%. There continues to be no wage base limitation on Medicare wages (SSHI), and the tax rate remains 1.45%.
- Contribution Limits The 2024 employee contribution limit for the 401(k), 403(b) and 457 plans will increase from \$22,500 to \$23,000 and the catch-up contribution limit for participants aged 50 or over will remain the same at \$7,500.
- Peer Mentor Applications: The First Year Experience Program is currently seeking peer mentor recommendations for the fall 2024 semester. A peer mentor is a current student who has successfully completed at least one semester at LC and helps new freshmen build a foundation for personal success at LC State. Peer mentors are friendly, reliable, supportive, and are able to demonstrate leadership qualities inside and outside the classroom. Mentors serve roughly 25 mentees 5-6 hours a week during orientation class, support programs (Orientation Day, Discovery Day, Homecoming, study nights, etc.), outreach and in-person meetings.
