Application Agreements

Please read the statements below.

I understand:

I am expected to stay with the host family I am placed with. If I want to change families, I must talk to the International Programs Retention Specialist and submit a new Homestay application (+ \$100 application fee). International Programs may decide not to collect an additional application fee. There is no guarantee that an alternative host family will be available.

I understand:

Although the Retention Specialist will try his/her best to match me with a host family that has all of my preferences, there are a limited number of host families and I might not be placed with an exact match.

I understand

Many host families do not allow smoking inside or directly outside of their home. I must respect my host's smoking rules – including cleaning up my cigarette butts.

I understand:

Many host families live 15-20 minutes away from Lewis-Clark State College. The International Programs Office cannot guarantee me a family near campus. In this case, my host family is responsible for my transportation to and from school, but I am responsible for all other transportation.



I understand:

An important part of the Homestay Program is spending time with my host family (including a meal every day). If I have other plans, I must communicate with my host family.

I understand:

If I am moving out of my host's home, I must give them 30-day written notice. If I do not give them 30-day notice, they have the right to the full month's rent, even if I am leaving earlier than 1 month.

I understand:

I have read and I agree to everything in the Homestay Student Contract. If I do not follow the rules in the Homestay Student Contract, I will not be allowed to stay in the Homestay Program.

I understand:

If I am younger than 21, I cannot drink alcohol in the USA – even if I can do it in my home country. Even if I am 21 or older, my hosts might not allow me to drink alcohol in their home, I must respect their rules.
