ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Idaho Resident Applicants:

- Must be a *new*, direct transfer student to LC State for Fall Semester 2024 from an Idaho Community College
- Must submit a recommendation letter from a qualified Physical, Life and Movement Sciences faculty with application

Non-Resident Applicants:

- Must be a *new*, direct transfer student to LC State for Fall Semester 2024, with preference given to applicants from Alaska, Hawaii, Montana, New Mexico, Nevada and Wyoming
- Must be majoring in Physical, Life and Movement Sciences

All Applicants:

- Must have a completed Associate Degree
- Must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled full-time (12 or more credits) per semester
- Must be degree seeking in a Bachelor degree program
- Students who are concurrently enrolled at LC State are not eligible
- Students who currently have an approved Consortium Agreement with LC State are not eligible
- Students who have earned dual or concurrent enrolled credits prior to high school graduation and attend the first semester after high school graduation will be considered Freshman for scholarship purposes and therefore ineligible to apply/receive Transfer Scholarships
- Renewable per terms of contract
