Johanna reporting:

- Library has an open position but haven't gotten permission to fill
  - President Pemberton and Dr. Chilson have asked for an evaluation of all Library employees' duties and tasks and "Where do we want the library to be moving into the future?"
  - Looking for someone who can complement e-Learning Services, make online content/resources, and conduct internet research
  - Brought in an external person, Scott Corbitt, [*President/CEO* Valley Vision, Inc.] to evaluate all library job duties/descriptions
- RRF Request: nothing requested at this time
- Other areas of potential budget reduction:
  - Change to the software used in the library for printing, automating certain computer tasks
- LC Library used to be part of WIN (Washington Idaho Network); only three standing libraries in the network; LC State Library is leaving WIN next fiscal year – End of June 2022.
  - Moving forward with an MOU instead of being part of this consortium (cost savings)
- Hosted Rock the Final (Nov 30<sup>th</sup> /Dec 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - Had prizes for students; President Pemberton came Wednesday (Dec 1<sup>st</sup>) to hand out prizes
  - Had about 30+ people each night
  - Jennifer Cromer hosted both nights
- December 2021:
  - Art installation going up in the Library for Tirazheh Eslami's art students
- Next spring:
  - Hoping to reinstate the snack cart for Finals in Spring Semester 2022.
