

Requirements for an Idaho Driver's License or Idaho Identification Card

Driving Directions:

The Nez Perce County Driver's License Office is located in the Nez Perce County Sheriff's office on Highway 128, a continuation of Down River Road. From campus, travel east. Make a left turn onto 21st Street. Continue straight across Memorial Bridge on Highway 12, staying in the left lane. Just after the traffic light, make a left turn onto Down River Road/128. Take a left onto Wall Street.

Items to bring:

- Legal Presence Documents
 - Passport with Visa
 - Documentation authorizing stay in the US for a limited time period
 - I-94 printout
 - I-20 (F1 students) or DS-2019 (J1 students)
- Social Security Card, or a letter of denial from the Social Security Administration stating that you cannot receive an Social Security Card.
- Proof of current Idaho residency: lease/rental/housing contract or utility bill.

Driver's License Testing

In order to get your Idaho Driver's License, you will need to pass a written and driving test. Study the [Idaho Driver's Handbook](#) before you test to become familiar with Idaho driving rules and regulations. Driver's License testing is by appointment ONLY. Schedule [online](#) through the Nez Perce County Sheriff's website or call 208-799-3138. Testing hours are 8 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Driver's licenses and state ID cards are only issued for 1 year or when your I-20 expires, whichever date is sooner. Seniors are advised to apply well before OPT start date.
