Merging courses? Submit merge requests to our Canvas IT Administrator using the Help Desk email: helpdesk@lcsc.edu. Include specifics about which classes need to be merged (semester, course number, section numbers). Section merges for Fall courses must be submitted **by August 10**.

Are you copying course content from a previous semester? Here's a [refresher video on copying course content](#) -OR- If you need content from a course taught by another instructor, please email your Chair to get permission and CC your instructional designer. We do those copies for you!

We recommend adjusting due dates or removing dates during the copy process. This prevents Canvas from auto-assigning zeros to "late" work based on due dates from a past term. For Fall course copies, use the following start and end dates:

- Beginning date: August 15, 2025, **change to** August 21, 2026
- Ending date: December 15 2025, **change to** December 2, 2026
