

Military Provisional Acceptance Plan BSN Basic Track

21 Month plan- Fall entrance to BSN program or 24 Month plan- Spring entrance to BSN program

Suggested plan of study for current enlisted personnel who are seeking a military scholarship. Plan includes application to Lewis-Clark State College BSN Program for provisional admission. Students must have completed all prerequisite coursework by July 17th for Fall (Aug) nursing start, or December 17th for Spring (Jan) start.

General Education Core Requirements

General education core classes need to be planned carefully. Six credits can be completed during each summer session once fully admitted to the BSN program. These must be completed by the final semester of the nursing program. Students may <u>not</u> be enrolled in these courses concurrent with nursing courses.

- Humanities Core (Art/Lit/Language)—2 courses, different disciplines
- Social Science Core--2 courses, different disciplines
- Diversity Core
- Integrative Seminar Upper Core (Ethics/Values)

Prerequisite Courses-- Please see the college catalog for full descriptions of the courses so that proper content and level of coursework are taken.

These courses must be completed <u>prior</u> to final application for provisional admission to nursing:

- BIOL 227/228 Anatomy and Physiology and lab⁸ semester credits
- CHEM 105 Organic and Biochemistry and lab⁴ semester credits
- BIOL 250 Microbiology and lab[^] 4 semester credits
- MATH 153 Statistics^ 3 semester credits

These courses must be completed prior to the start of the nursing program at LC State:

- BIOL 312 Pathophysiology (300 level course or greater)
- Oral Communications
- HLTH 253 Nutrition
- English 101 (Writing & Rhetoric I)
- Research Writing (Engl 102: Writing & Rhetoric II)
- Math core (may be taken as Stats class)

Miscellaneous:

- All required courses must be passed with a "C" or better to be eligible
- Courses above marked with a ^ must have a combined min. GPA of 2.75
- Must meet min. cumulative GPA of 2.5 from all college/university coursework taken

Minimum English Language Proficiency for Non-Native English Speakers

Must have taken TOEFL exam within the last two years, contact an NHS program advisor for details.
